- 6. Reports
  - i. Trustee's report (Debbie Laturnus/Sharon Rutledge)
    - a. Transportation Accountability Report presented at today's board meeting by Dave Shaw.
      - i. 85 buses with 58 daily routes
      - ii. average age of a bus is ~8.7 years
      - iii. 1778 students/day travelling over 1.8 million kms/year
      - iv. buses are inspected 2x/year, taking 2-3 days/inpection
      - v. 2017 was accident free
      - vi. Think of us on the Bus campaign has been and continues to be a good program. This year, a split bus evacuation was done at the schools.
      - vii. 10 additional cameras were purchased, totalling 40 camera systems
    - b. OH & S Accountability Report
      - i. Public School Works is a program that sends out courses for employees to complete.
      - ii. 9060 courses were sent out since Jan 1, 2017. Incompleteion rate is 10.8%.
    - c. Draft AP 552-Inclement Weather
