

Cell Phone Policy

While improvements in technology, both in equipment and capabilities, continue to expand, and while the educational use of technology for students will continue to play an important role in the education of students in our school, decisions need to be made as to the educational and personal use of that technology.

The use of cell phones by students during the school day is prohibited. Adequate access to telephones is provided to students within the school should they need to use them. Cell phones are to be kept in lockers and turned off for the day. Students who have or are using cell phones during the school day will have them taken immediately and given to administration. Students can pick up cell phones after school. If this occurs 3 or more times, parents will be called and the cell phone can be picked up by parents.

Parents or volunteers who come into the school are asked to limit their use of cell phones to areas and times that do not interfere with the learning environment of the school including classrooms, concerts, assemblies or any such place where students are gathered.

Compliance with this policy protects the rights and privacy of all our students and does not distract from the learning environment of the classroom or school in general. Parents and volunteers who assist in our school are asked to adhere to this policy as well when they are visiting or helping in our school.
