In School Suspension (ISS)

The student remains in school. All privileges are suspended. Student brings lunch and eats in isolation; classes are not attended.

While on ISS, the student will be provided with materials and assignments that are relevant, realistic, and appropriate, and will be responsible for the completion of these assignments.

If the student is disruptive during an ISS, he/she will be given one warning. Should the disruptive behavior continue, he/she will phone his/her parents/guardian to discuss being picked up at school. If the parent/guardian is unable to pick up their son/daughter, he/she will arrange for an emergency person to do so. An out-of-school suspension may be initiated at this point. A record of the incident and student plan of action will be maintained in the teacher's/school file.
