Hi everyone,



GRADE 4 POD

We have been busy getting settled into our new routines and exploring our new school. All students will have access to Google Classroom soon, please check your child's Palliser email for the invitation.

We encourage families to read every night to help build reading fluency, stamina and confidence. A reminder that Home Journals went out at the end of last week and parents/guardians need to initial and send back the journal at the start of every week. Remember to log in to Edsby to see your child's progress and report absences. Don't forget to check Google Classroom if they are absent.

GRADE 5 POD

We have had a great start to the year! We are beginning our Space unit in Science, Mapping in Social Studies, and Coordinate Geometry and Algebra in Math. In Language Arts each class has a different book that we are reading together as a class and we are also starting with assessments to learn where our students are at.

All students should now have access to Google Classroom where they will be able to access materials that are being covered in the classroom while they are away from school. Remember to log into Edsby to check your child' progress and to report any absences.





GRADE 6 POD

We are getting used to our homeroom routines and practicing how we prepare for each subject in grade 6. Students will have access to their homeroom Google Classroom soon, and all subject material will be posted here. Students should be trying to do some reading at home and practicing their math facts each evening to help establish good study habits as doing these two tasks, even for 20 minutes per night, will help with all subjects.
