GRADE 4 POD

We have started to get into routines and find our rhythm!

SWAP is going to be starting at the beginning of November. The purpose of this is to provide targeted intervention for kids. In this SWAP round, we will focus on word work, with a targeted focus on spelling. At the beginning of the week, students will be coming home with spelling words to help understand our learning strategy for the week. Please review and practice these words with your child.





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
